Introducing Swedish Economic Policy Review

■ This is the first issue of *Swedish Economic Policy Review*. Its purpose is to publish research on economic policy of particular relevance for Sweden. The *Review* is edited and published by the Economic Council of Sweden, a body of academic economists commissioned by the Swedish government to initiate and provide information about research of importance for economic policy and to advise the Ministry of Finance and the National Institute of Economic Research in scientific matters.

Swedish Economic Policy Review will address issues of economic performance that confront policymakers and do so in a way that is intelligable to the interested, informed non-specialist and useful to the professional economist. The *Review* will be open to a wide range of issues and give emphasis to quantitative analysis.

Articles in the *Review* will be commissioned from leading experts in Sweden and abroad. Members of the Economic Council will act as a panel and discuss articles with the authors prior to publication. Many articles are expected to originate from papers presented at conferences and workshops organized by the Economic Council, as is the case with the articles in this first issue.

Journals that publish theoretical and empirical economic research abound, whereas journals that bring the research findings to bear more directly on issues of economic performance facing policymakers are few. Moreover, the natural emphasis placed by research journals on theory and method makes important findings inaccessible to non-specialist readers. *Swedish Economic Policy Review* should therefore serve an important function inside as well as outside Sweden.
