## Information to foreign missions in Sweden – New procedures for population registration certificates

Foreign missions often demand a stamped and signed population registration certificate for various cases. To date, the Swedish Tax Agency has stamped and signed all pages. **As of November 7, 2016, we will only stamp and sign the last page.** 

At the same time, the Swedish Tax Agency will also begin to refer customers to our website for ordering stamped population registration certificates. The certificate will then be sent within five working days to the recipient's registered home address, or registered separate address when applicable.

The new procedures are a result of the great and steadily increasing demand for stamped and signed population registration certificates. The change of stamping and signing only the last page of the certificate has been made in consultation with the Swedish Ministry for Foreign Affairs.

The Swedish Tax Agency hope you are able to convey this information to authorities and stakeholders in your home country, that request population registration certificates (e.g. banks and insurance companies).
