




Sweden's support to Ukraine

Sweden's assistance since February 2022 *

MILITARY SUPPORT	SEK 16.9 billion (approx. EUR 1,5 billion)
HUMANITARIAN SUPPORT	SEK 1.82 billion (approx. EUR 162 million)
FINANCIAL SUPPORT	SEK 1.1 billion (approx. EUR 98 million)
CIVILIAN CRISIS MANAGEMENT	SEK 500 million (approx. EUR 45 million)
RECONSTRUCTION	SEK 750 million (approx. EUR 58 million)
REFORM SUPPORT	SEK 316 million (approx. EUR 28 million)
SUPPORT TO FREE MEDIA, CYBER SECURITY, ACCOUNTABILITY, NUCLEAR SAFETY etc.	SEK 156 million (approx. EUR 13 million)

-  Sweden also supports Ukraine through the EU and the UN.
-  Sweden has received some 50 000 Ukrainian refugees.
-  Sweden has supported Ukraine since the 1990s. Until the end of 2021, Sweden's support to Ukraine amounted to just over SEK 4 billion (approx. EUR 357 million).
